S'mores are usually made over the campfire. The marshmallow is roasted over the fire until it becomes very soft. Then, graham crackers with pieces of chocolate are used to sandwich the roasted marshmallow. The heat from the marshmallow will melt the chocolate.

This delicious treat always leaves children wanting more. In fact, that is probably how it got its name, s'more which means "some more".

If you do not have a campfire, you can still make s'mores in your kitchen using the microwave oven. You can enjoy them anytime - at breakfast, lunch, dinner or tea break. However, the best part about making s'mores is to put them over an open fire. Just make sure that there is an adult around when you are making them.
