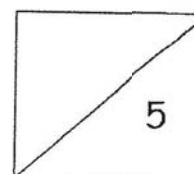

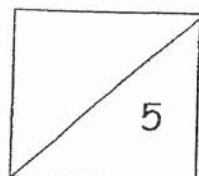
Questions 6 to 10
