The enclosures for the animals are specially designed to look like their homes in the wild in order for them to feel at ease and lead a natural lifestyle. The result is healthy and happy animals which can be encouraged to breed. It is important for the endangered animals to reproduce for species survival so that future generations may one day return to the wild.

The Singapore Zoological Gardens is one of the world's leading zoos. It houses 2530 animals, including 50 endangered ones, from 315 species. Visitors at the zoo are able to learn about the natural world and wildlife conservation.
