"I have done nothing extraordinary and everyone who wants to can do it. I do not place great importance on money. When I donate to help others, I feel happy and I can sleep well at night."

"My philosophy in life is simple: If doing something makes you worried, then it must be wrong. If it makes you happy, then you must have done the right thing. What others say is not important," says Chen.
