**Section G: Comprehension 2 (10 marks)**

Read the passage carefully and answer the questions that follow.

Puppets have been around for a long time. They have a global appeal as people are drawn to the stories that each puppet can act out.

There are different types of puppets. Hand puppets use hand movements to give "life" to the puppet. They can be made of cloth or even paper. Stick puppets make use of sticks to support the upper body of the puppet. Rod puppets have rods and wires hooked to them to make them move. String puppets move by strings or wires hooked to different parts of their bodies. 5

The person who makes puppets come to life is called a puppeteer. First, the puppeteer hides himself. Next, the puppeteer speaks with little or no lip movement such that the sound appears to come from the puppet! Then, he matches the movements of the puppet's mouth with the spoken part. One of the most famous puppeteers of all time was Jim Henson. He created characters such as Big Bird and Cookie Monster. 10

The puppeteer stays hidden so that it is easier for people watching to use their imagination during a puppet show. The type of stage used for a puppet show depends on the type of puppets. A table, a large box, or the floor can be used as a stage. 15

Music is used in many puppet shows. Music sets the mood. It also provides the sound that accompanies the puppets' movements. The use of lighting has also enabled puppet productions to achieve realistic and spectacular effects. Hence, many factors make a puppet show a success. 20
