



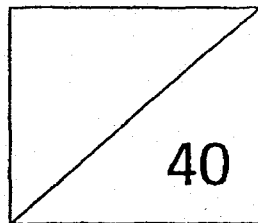

Most birds build their nests in places with many trees and lots of grass, but not the birds that live in Antarctica. This is because these nests, made up of twigs and dried leaves, will allow the frigid Antarctic winds through the gaps in the nests. The winds will chill and kill the chick in the egg. The icy surface of the Antarctica will also freeze the egg in the nest very quickly.

The Emperor Penguins of Antarctica do not build nests in Antarctica, a place that only has ice and snow. The females lay one egg each year in winter, the coldest time of the year. When the egg is laid, the female goes off to hunt while the male penguin keeps the egg warm. The parents take turns to balance the egg on top of their feet, keeping it off the ground. It is tucked under their bulging stomachs and is kept warm with their feathers.

As the temperature drops, the ocean waters near the place where the eggs are laid also freeze. This adds kilometres of ice that the female penguins must cross to get to the waters where they can swim and hunt. Yet, this also protects the chicks from hunters that could come from the ocean. It is so cold during mid-winter that no other animals live in Antarctica during the winter. With no possible predators around, the chicks can hatch safely. By spring, the chicks have grown much bigger and have a better chance to swim away from danger.

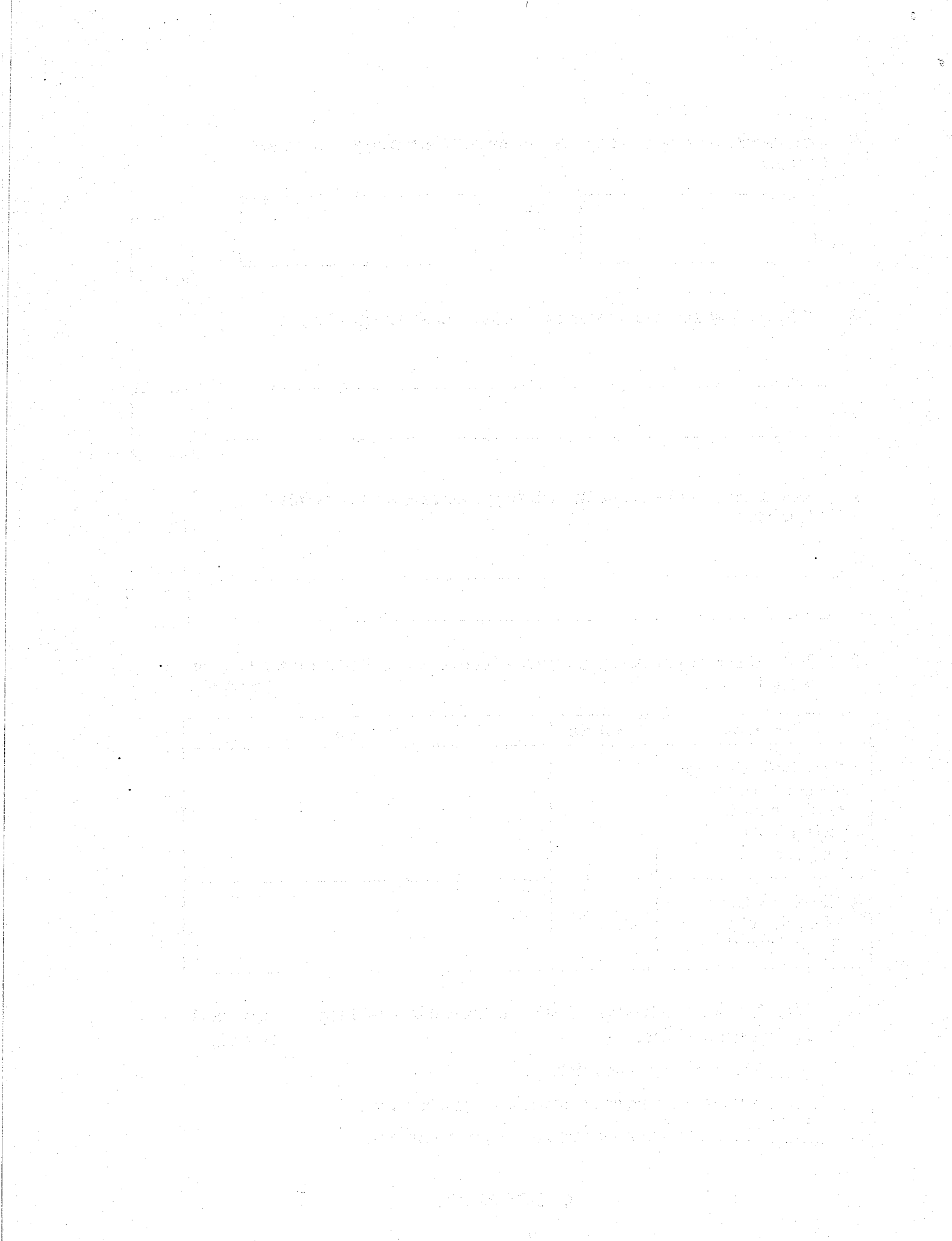
